This year I went for a real change from the searing heat of Mozambique to my first visit to the sub zero mountains and frozen rivers of Alaska. Together with my hunting companion and friend of many trips, Phil Nicholson, we enjoyed the hunting, the incredible scenery and warm hospitality of Kodiak Island for 10 days. On this trip I managed the Larsen Bay equivalent to a Scottish McNabb. This equates to, that in one day, we took our limit of halibut (up to 10kg), one Sitka blacktail deer and the bag limit of Harlequin sea ducks. Quite an achievement for only 8 hours of daylight.

The Redbanks shoot calendar for next season has very limited days left already. Argentina 1st July 2007 has 3 positions left for a 7 day hunt (4 days on water fowl & 3 days of extreme hot barrel) - not to be missed. South Africa – Poplin Ranch on the Limpopo River is an extremely exciting destination for first time hunters to Africa. Mozambique has limited late season buffalo/sable hunts for 2007, in a magnificent location of a truly wild Africa. For those of you who want a truly unique adventure, contact us about Kodiak Island. With no duck season declared for Victoria in 2007 we only have 4 trips available for the New Zealand duck season in June/July 2007.

Once again remember if you don't want to be disappointed and miss out, please book early for whatever destination you choose.

Thank-you to all of you who have allowed us to take care of your travels in 2006, and we hope you will continue to keep our destinations and adventures on your wish list for 2007.

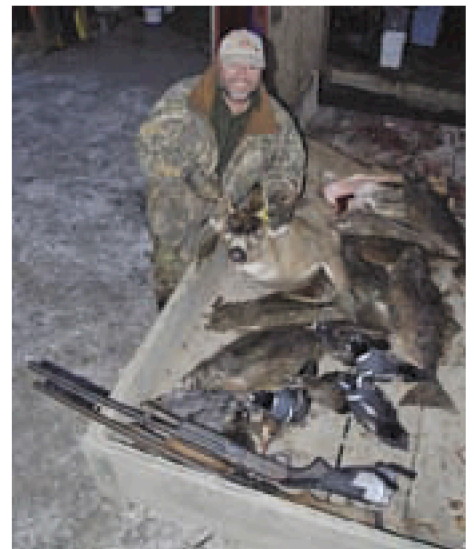
