



State Championships will be hosted by Southern Districts Rifle Club, Bedfordale.

In May 1982, Andie Currie placed an advertisement in a local paper asking that anyone interested in forming a shooting club attend an informational meeting he had organised. More than 100 people responded to his ad and as a result a suitable sight for the Southern Districts Rifle Club (SDRC) just outside of Perth was found. During the first year of operation, SDRC had about 40 members. Throughout the years the Club has seen considerable growth. The Club has a 200m range that has closed in shooting mounds with 27 shooting bays. Facilities feature toilets, hot showers, a canteen and bar facilities. An additional 50m range has recently been completed and offers a closed in shooting mound with 20 shooting bays. The Club is host to several events throughout the year. It regularly hosts the Single Action State Roundup and also the Scoped 3 Positional and Field Rifle State Championships as well as operating registered matches for Club Championships and hosting National Competitions on rotation with other States.

The competition is graded and all levels of shooters are encouraged to attend. Eligibility is open to all current financial members of SSAA. Medals for 1st, 2nd & 3rd in each grade per event plus junior categories U/18 & U/15, 1st, 2nd, & 3rd in each open Two Gun and the open Four Gun Championship. Certificates for 1st in each position plus points towards the WA Hall of Fame in Field Rifle & 3 Positional for position wins, event wins and 1st, 2nd & 3rd in the Two Gun events.

WESTERN AUSTRALIAN STATE Junior & Open Records are eligible to be broken in this event. Junior & Open AUSTRALIAN records are also eligible to be broken which, if shot, will remain provisional until ratified by the National Field Rifle Sub-Committee meeting over Easter 2023.
