What is Gallery Rifle?

Gallery Rifle is for Pistol Calibre Lever Action Rifles with an integral tube magazine ONLY.

Either hand loaded or factory loaded ammunition may be used. All ammunition must have sufficient energy to pass through paper/card targets and their backing boards. Shots which do not pass through such targets will be scored as misses.

The use of slings is prohibited.

Two types of sights are permitted:

Iron. Iron sights which may include sights of any colour, (except in Classic Class)

Optical. Optical sights may include telescopic and 'red dot' sights but not lasers which project onto the target itself.

Sights in Classic Class must be open sights. (Tang or Buckhorn style rear and blade on the front). The blade must not have any form of light gathering insert. It can only have a white or bronze bead.

The championships will be held over 2 days and consist of 6 events as per nomination form.
