Please note the following conditions that will apply for the 2026 National Big Game Rifle Championship:

- 1. Competition** - on Friday 6 November competition is restricted to only the Shoot Marshall's, who will be conducting the competition on Saturday 7 November. The Main Range 1 at Eagle Park will be open to anyone who wants to practice on Friday 6 November.
- 2. Optical Sights** - this includes any sort of optical sight such as a telescopic or 'red dot' sight. Optical sights can be used without penalty. No optical sights may be used in the Black Powder or Bore Gun events.
- 3. Course of Fire** - a reduced course of fire will apply (see accompanying flyer and below)

The following courses of fire and qualifying rifles need to be read in conjunction with the Big Game Rifle National rules.

Dangerous Game – Stopping Class Rifles only

Additional information on the Dangerous Game event:

- Only rifles meeting Stopping Class criteria can be used;
- Each competitor will have a cartridge selected at random and shoot it over a chronograph to measure its velocity in order to calculate bullet energy;
- The shooter will adopt a 'ready' position with both hands on an empty rifle. Upon receiving the commencement signal they will load two rounds fire them, then load two more and fire them.
- The shooter will have the time taken to make their 4 shots measured by an electronic timer;
- The targets will be an animal target(s) which will have a scoring zone(s) marked with an inner scoring ring with a value of '5' points and an outer scoring ring with a value of '2' points. Maximum points score is 20;
- The score for a competitor will be a function of bullet energy, points score and time taken to complete the 4 scoring shots;
