

## **Single Action Holster Proficiency**

All SSAA members who wish to compete in a SSAA Single Action competition are required to provide proof of their Single Action Holster Proficiency.

Each competitor is responsible to ensure they have the relevant holster qualification for Single Action Shooting approved by their club or state, or a recognised international qualification.

A competitor may be asked to provide written evidence of holster proficiency before being allowed to compete in a Single Action match using a holster.

It is the competitor's responsibility to carry proof of their holster proficiency.
